

2 Year Health Guarantee

We guarantee the puppy to be in good health to the best of our knowledge at time of sale. This 2 year health guarantee covers all heart problems that result in the death of a puppy. To keep this guarantee valid, the puppy must be examined by a licensed veterinarian within 4 days of taking the puppy home. If the Veterinarian finds the puppy to have LIFE THREATENING issues directly caused by the condition of the puppy's heart at birth, the puppy must be returned to the breeder within 72 hours of purchase, accompanied with a vet certificate or statement from the vet stating the reason for the return. The seller assumes no responsibility for charges incurred by the purchaser for this service. The seller will refund the purchaser the full purchase price or give the purchaser a replacement puppy of equal value if the purchaser chooses so from the next available litter*. If for any reason the death of a puppy should occur within the 2 year contract, and it is caused directly by the heart (proven by both breeders vet and purchasers vet), the purchaser will be given a new puppy at the next available litter*. This will only happen after an autopsy is performed, and both the buyers vet and breeders vet agree that the cause is the heart condition of the pup. This autopsy will be performed at the owner's expense. A copy of the vet report and autopsy must be presented within 3 days of the death. On the documents it must be made clear the identity of the puppy with the microchip number. The breeders will require the original/ hard copies of every document including but not limited to the signed copy of this contract, the signed copy of the vet report(s), the signed copy of the autopsy, and any other paperwork pertaining to the claim. If the puppy's death is a result of abuse or neglect, this guarantee is **VOID**. Common parasites, fleas, ticks, worms, allergies, murmurs, skin conditions, eye issues etc. are not cause for replacement as they are not LIFE THREATENING problems. Also, cherry eye and any common non life threatening breed issues are not covered under this contract. If a purchased puppy is found to have a life threatening health problem at its initial veterinary visit and purchaser opts to treat this puppy instead of exchanging it for another puppy or a refund, the breeder will not be responsible for any expenses incurred or for the death of the puppy, and no refunds or replacements will be made, nor will any credits be issued. The breeders are in no way responsible for any vet costs or specialist's costs of any kind at any time, and will not reimburse for any medical costs.

Purchasers must provide hard copy proof of spay/neuter from their vet with microchip number and vet signature by 12 months of the puppies date of birth. This contract will become void if a spay/ neuter is performed before 6 months of age. After receiving this document, CKC papers will be issued to the purchaser. If the purchaser fails to provide proof of spay/neuter by 12 months, the purchaser will forfeit any rights to the bulldog pup, receive no refund of payments and the pup will be returned to the breeder with all paperwork and vet certificates at the expense of the purchaser. This condition is to protect against non certified breeding and to protect the English Bulldog breed, breeders and clubs associated with the English Bulldog.

We do not guarantee that this is a show puppy, suitable for breeding or the size and color of this puppy. No money shall be refunded for these reasons and the seller shall not be held responsible for any veterinarian bills.

If the purchaser decides that the dog has a non-life threatening defect of any kind, or a life threatening defect and has it repaired at any time in the puppy's life, all costs for surgeries, medications, etc., will be covered by the buyer.

The following conditions are to be followed for the safety of your dog. If any of the following are not applied the Health Guarantee is **VOID**:

Puppies **must** have clean and fresh water at **all** times.

As well, puppies **must** be given sufficient amounts of **proper** food.

Puppy **must** be kept clean, warm and dry.

If outside, this puppy **must** be accompanied by someone if not in a secure enclosure.

Puppy must not be eating leaves, plants, rocks, snow, table scraps or sticks

Finally, any puppy sold by Paul and Stacy Vidic are **NOT** for **ANY** reason to be surrendered to any animal shelter or humane society. If for **ANY** reason you cannot care for your puppy, the breeder is to be notified so that we can find the proper home for the dog.

Vidic's Bullies strongly suggests that you take your dog to obedience training. Pet insurance is also highly recommended for your puppy.

*Available litter is a litter that has not already had deposits made before their birth. The breeder will not refuse deposits of puppies to hold a puppy for a replacement. Deposits on a litter before the litter is born will be honored first, than the replacement puppy will be chosen. If the number of deposits made before the litter is born is more than the amount of

puppies born, then that litter no longer is an available litter and the buyer must continue to wait for an available litter to be born.

The buyer therefore understands all that is mentioned above and agrees to all terms and conditions.
